First visit

Copper is such a sweet boy!

We worked with the relaxation techniques and essential oils. He responded very well.

Copper was assessed and the assessment showed he was in need of Trauma Release. I also applied techniques to his injury site. Copper responds so well to the work. He really enjoys it.

I was at Copper's home for a period of time working with the other dogs. The owner reported that she watched Copper walk after his session and he was not limping.

2nd visit

Copper was assessed and it was found that he would benefit from vertebral release techniques. Relaxation techniques and essential oils were used. Vertebral release was completed. In addition, tuning fork work was done this day. His old injury site was also worked on (deer injury site).

Copper loves this work! He shows steady improvement with the work.

The owner comments that she sees improvement in Copper after the sessions.
